Follow these tips to **stop the spread**



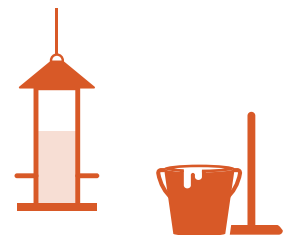
SPOT AND REPORT the signs of avian influenza

In Ontario, report a sick or dead bird to the Canadian Wildlife Health Cooperative

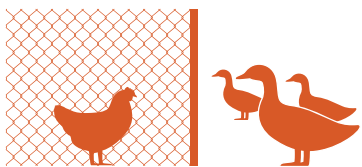
DO NOT TOUCH or feed wild birds by hand

If you are a hunter or are otherwise in contact with wild birds, always follow safe handling practices.



CLEAN backyard bird feeders and baths regularly

Use a weak solution of domestic bleach (10% sodium hypochlorite), rinse well, and allow time to dry.



SEPARATE domestic and wild birds

Minimize contact between domestic and wild birds. Change or wash clothing and footwear before interacting with domestic or pet birds.



CONSERVE migratory bird habitat

Birds that have access to high quality habitat and food are more resilient to disease.
